ROBERT "ERV" STEINER

U.S. NAVY 1943 - 1945

Erv Steiner enlisted in the Navy as an Apprentice Seaman in a construction battalion, Seabees, on Sept. 18, 1943. His training took place at Camp Peary, VA. Then Erv was transferred for duty aboard the USS LST 1033 when the ship was commissioned. During WWII his ship was assigned to the Asiatic Pacific Theater and participating in the assault of Iwo Jima and Okinawa. He was also engaged in the occupation of Japan. While aboard ship he was initiated into the Royal Order of Golden Dragons, and the Ancient Order of Shellbacks. He was awarded the following medals. Victory Medal, Asiatic-Pacific Medal, Philippine Liberation Medal and the American Theatre Medal.

THOMAS HENRY BURGESS STEINER

U.S. ARMY 1942 - 1945

Tom Steiner enlisted in the Army in October of 1942. His MOS was as an airplane elections specialist. Tom was a sharpshooter with a pistol and carbine. He was involved in the following battles and campaigns: Rome-Arno; Normandy; Northern France; Rhineland; Southern France, Central Europe and Ardennes. He received the following decorations and citations: EAME Theater Ribbon w/7 Bronze Stars, Good Conduct Ribbon; and the Distinguished Unit Citation. Tom received an honorable discharge on September 12, 1945

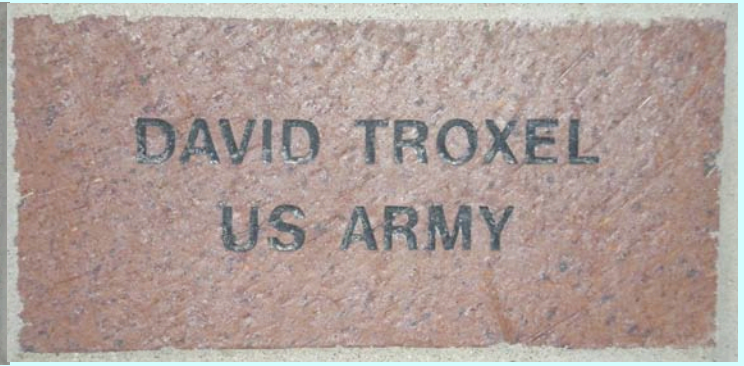


JAMES ROBERT STEINER

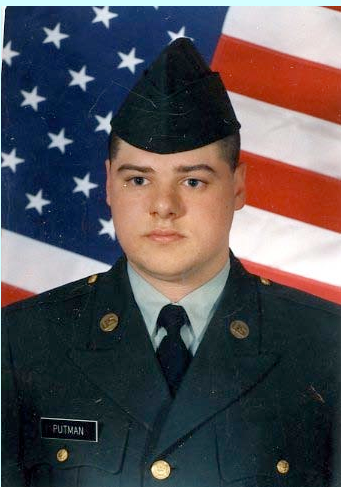
